Gender Audit Report

Gender Audit

A gender audit is a technique to evaluate and verify how integrated gender equality is within an organization, including in its policies, programs, projects, and/or service delivery. It is a technique of evaluation that analyzes the organization's gender equality status quo and identifies the primary gender biases. A gender audit would focus on various topics, including the status of gender equality in organizational culture, policy and decision-making structures, and processes, as well as to gather staff perceptions, understandings, and behaviors about the issue at hand. Organizations can improve aspects of their organizational culture that discriminate against female employees and female "beneficiaries" by conducting gender audits.

Objectives

- · To learn about the institution's gender balance
- To learn about how people on campus see gender by surveying the staff to learn how they view gender equality in the workplace and in programs
- To establish a plan for gender action

Gender Balance within the institution

Gender balance refers to the presence of an equitable distribution of male and female students in the institution's various programs and staff structures, as well as among the total number of students enrolled in those programs.




Fig. 1: Male: Female student ration Year wise




Fig. 2: Male: Female student ration Year wise




Fig. 3: Male: Female student ration Year wise



1.Is the college taking any measures to promote gender equity


