i) Solar Energy

Vaagdevi College of Pharmacy introduced Solar Energy in 2019 with a 210 Solar Photovoltaic (PV) with a capacity of 100 KW solar on grid system with net metering capability and capacity of each module proposed is 325 W. In order to use renewable energy, college have solar panels put on their rooftops. At our college, solar technology is used to implement energy conservation measures and for to produce electricity on a large scale. The main electrical grid is connected to a solar PV system to allow power generated by solar panels.



ii) Wheeling to the Grid

The solar panels send the energy to the Grid during low load conditions in the campus. The Electrical power is wheeled back to the Grid every month after the consumption of solar power in the campus. This helps the Grid in supply the energy to other loads during that period.




ii) Liquid Waste Management




Water Distribution Systems in the College from the Tanks







As part of an NSS programme every year, tree plantation takes place in the college grounds and in nearby villages to promote environmentally friendly practices.










V) Scribe Software: The institute provide the scribe software for the students who are blind and visually impaired persons to read the screen either with a text to speech output.
